

Sulwath Galloway Gold 5.0% ABV

Sulwath Brewery, Castle Douglas, Dumfries and Galloway. Est. 1996

This golden beer has a floral, fruity aroma, leading to biscuit and citrus fruit flavours, culminating in a crisp, refreshing finish. Hops: Challenger, Saaz

Innis & Gunn Nc'Nean 6.8% ABV

Innis & Gunn Brewerv, Perthshire, Est. 2003

This new oatmeal stout has been matured in Nc'Nean organic single-malt whisky casks, resulting in a robust, full-bodied character, with roasted malt and whisky flavours. Hops: Goldinas, Super Styrian

This brilliant orange beer is light and refreshing in character, with a distinctive flavour and a sweet, yet crisp, finish. Hops: Summit

Loch Lomond Zoom Time 4.5% ABV 440ml can

Loch Lomond Brewery, West Dunbartonshire. Est. 2011 This hazy orange, light and refreshing New England IPA has aromas of stone fruit and pineapple, leading to a citrus fruit explosion and a juicy, sweet finish. Hops: Amarillo, Galaxy, Mosaic

Fierce IPA 5.0% ABV 440ml can

Fierce Beer, Aberdeenshire. Est. 2016 This bright golden beer has a sweet, juicy aroma of fruit and caramel, leading to bittersweet citrus zest flavours and a crisp, refreshing finish. Hops: Citra, Mosaic

Stewart New Relic 5.6% ABV 440ml can Stewart Brewing, Midlothian. Est. 2004

This straw-coloured slightly hazy IPA is full of begutiful stone fruit and blueberry notes, resulting in a full-flavoured character, with a lasting finish. Hops: Mosaic

Fierce Noir 4.3% ABV

Hops: Citra

Fierce Beer, Aberdeen, Aberdeenshire. Est. 2016 This classic full-bodied black stout has an aroma of dark chocolate and roast malt, leading to fresh coffee and dark fruit flavours. Hops: East Kent Goldings



Orkney Sunstone 4.4% ABV

This new deep golden ale has orange, citrus and resinous notes in its aroma, leading to tangerine and spice flavours and a crisp, citrusy finish. Hops: Admiral, First Gold

Stewart Red Dawn Rising 4.6% ABV

Stewart Brewing, Loanhead, Midlothian. Est. 2004

This new amber beer has a caramel and toffee flavour, complemented by cherry and raspberry notes, resulting in a balance of bitterness and sweet maltiness. Hops: Cascade, Challenger, Citra, Goldings, Mandarina Bavaria, Mosaic

Fyne Ales Crofter's Treat 5.0% ABV

Fyne Ales, Cairndow, Argyll. Est. 2001

This new golden amber ESB has a malty aroma, leading to a biscuit and caramel flavour, balanced by a hoppy bitterness, to deliver a clean finish. Hops: Bramling Cross, Cascade (UK), Challenger

MòR Poly Vision 5.0% ABV MòR Beers, Kellas, Angus. Est. 2012

This new ruby-coloured fruited sour beer is packed with blackberry flavours, balanced by spicy hop notes, leading to a refreshing, crisp and sour finish. **Hops: Bramling Cross**
