## ALL YEAR ROUND

**Oakham JHB 3.8% ABV**  
Oakham Ales, Cambridgeshire. Est. 1993  
This light golden beer's aroma is dominated by citrus notes, with hops and fruit on the palate balanced by malty notes, leading to a dry, hoppy finish.  
**Hops:** *Challenger, Mount Hood*



**Wainwright Gold 4.1% ABV**  
Marston's Brewery, Staffordshire. Est. 1834  
(part of Carlsberg Marston's Brewing Company Group)  
This straw-coloured beer has a subtle sweetness supplied by honey notes, complemented by citrus fruit overtones, resulting in a balanced, refreshing character.  
**Hops:** *Hersbrucker, Magnum, Styrian Goldings, Tradition*



**Brains SA 4.2% ABV**  
Brains Brewery, Cardiff. Est. 1882  
This copper beer has a malty aroma, leading to a blend of nutty richness, with malty and intense fruit notes, balanced by a satisfying dryness in the finish.  
**Hops:** *Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings*



**Oakham Citra 4.2% ABV**  
Oakham Ales, Cambridgeshire. Est. 1993  
This pale golden beer expertly showcases its hop variety, with its pungent aromas of grapefruit, lychee and gooseberry leading to a refreshing finish.  
**Hops:** *Citra*



**Wychwood Hobgoblin Gold 4.2% ABV**  
Marston's Brewery, Staffordshire. Est. 1834  
(part of Carlsberg Marston's Brewing Company Group)  
This golden beer delivers citrus and passion fruit aromas, leading to biscuit malt flavours, complemented by refreshing lemon and lime zest.  
**Hops:** *Citra, Nelson Sauvin, Pilgrim, Summit*



**Adnams Ghost Ship 4.5% ABV**  
Adnams Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1872  
This golden pale ale has aromatic elderflower notes, with its balance of bold citrus flavours and a subtle malt backbone resulting in a refreshing hoppy finish.  
**Hops:** *Cascade, Chinook, Citra*



**Brains The Rev James Original 4.5% ABV**  
Brains Brewery, Cardiff. Est. 1882  
This mahogany beer has a spicy toffee aroma, followed by a rich, balanced character, with its mellow, malty flavour giving way to a clean, refreshing finish.  
**Hops:** *Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings*



**Exmoor Gold 4.5% ABV**  
Hogs Back Brewery, Surrey. Est. 1992  
This golden beer has an aroma of soft malt and citrus, followed by a subtle malt sweetness and a refreshing, bittersweet finish of citrus, toffee and vanilla.  
**Hops:** *Celeia, Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings*



**Morland Old Speckled Hen 4.5% ABV**  
Greene King Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1799  
This auburn beer has a superb fruity aroma, with its warming malt and toffee character balanced by fruity notes and hints of caramel, leading to a smooth finish.  
**Hops:** *Challenger, First Gold, Pilgrim*



**Wychwood Hobgoblin Ruby 4.5% ABV**  
Marston's Brewery, Staffordshire. Est. 1834  
(part of Carlsberg Marston's Brewing Company Group)  
This ruby ale has fruit and sweet caramel aromas, leading to a rich, full-bodied toffee flavour and a fruity finish, with notes of figs, raisins and dates.  
**Hops:** *Fuggles, Goldings, Styrian*



**Hook Norton Old Hooky 4.6% ABV**  
Hook Norton Brewery, Oxfordshire. Est. 1849  
This tawny-red bitter has a fruity, malty aroma and palate, with a balance of subtle hoppiness and hints of malt, creating a rounded, slightly sweet character.  
**Hops:** *Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings*



**Adnams Broadside 4.7% ABV**  
Adnams Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1872  
This deep ruby beer is rich in fruit cake aromas, with hints of almond and fruit in its smooth, malty flavour, leading to a balanced, lasting finish.  
**Hops:** *Pilgrim*



**Ringwood Fortyniner 4.9% ABV**  
Marston's Brewery, Staffordshire. Est. 1834  
(part of Carlsberg Marston's Brewing Company Group)  
This golden-brown beer has a light, fresh, floral aroma and a rounded malt flavour, balanced by moderate bitterness, leading to bittersweet notes in the finish.  
**Hops:** *Challenger, Fuggles, Goldings, Progress, Sovereign*



**Titanic Plum Porter 4.9% ABV**  
Titanic Brewery, Staffordshire. Est. 1985  
This deep red ale has a well-rounded flavour, with its sweet fruity notes balanced by an underlying hoppiness, resulting in an easy-drinking character.  
**Hops:** *Celeia, Goldings, Herkules, Pilgrim*



**Sharp's Sea Fury 5.0% ABV**  
Sharp's Brewery, Cornwall. Est. 1994  
This ruby ale has inviting berry and roast notes in its aroma, leading to a balanced full malt and fruit flavour, culminating in a pleasing, hoppy finish.  
**Hops:** *Aurora, Cascade, Chinook, Motueka*



**Theakston Old Peculier 5.6% ABV**  
Theakston Brewery, North Yorkshire. Est. 1827  
This classic dark ruby beer has a rich, full-bodied flavour, with subtle cherry and rich fruit overtones, plus a smooth, lasting finish.  
**Hops:** *Challenger, Fuggles, Target*



**Thornbridge Jaipur 5.9% ABV**  
Thornbridge Brewery, Derbyshire. Est. 2005  
This straw-coloured IPA delivers a citrus aroma, with its complex hoppiness building to a powerful citrus hop burst, culminating in a balanced, smooth finish.  
**Hops:** *Ahtanum, Cascade, Centennial, Chinook, Columbus, Simcoe*



**Greene King Abbot Reserve 6.5% ABV**  
Greene King Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1799  
This occasionally brewed deep amber beer has a fruity aroma, leading to a smooth, full-bodied flavour, bursting with biscuit, toffee and rich fruit cake notes.  
**Hops:** *Admiral, First Gold, Fuggles, Pilgrim*



# CRAFT BEERS

**Tenby Son of a Beach 4.2% ABV**  
Tenby Brewing, Pembrokeshire. Est. 2015  
This hazy straw-coloured pale ale has a hoppy flavour which delivers a pleasing blend of tropical fruit notes, resulting in a refreshing, lasting finish.  
**Hops:** *Ekuanot, Mosaic, Simcoe*



**Wilde Child Eye of the Tiger 4.2% ABV**  
Wilde Child Brewing, Yorkshire. Est. 2016  
This dark stout has a sweet, decadent character, with its addition of rocky road flavouring delivering chocolate and marshmallow notes.  
**Hops:** *Northern Brewer*



**Fierce Iron Brew 4.5% ABV**  
Fierce Beer, Aberdeenshire. Est. 2016  
This brilliant orange beer is light and refreshing in character, with a distinctive flavour and sweet, yet crisp, finish.  
**Hops:** *Summit*



**Loch Lomond Zoom Time 4.5% ABV**  
Loch Lomond Brewery, West Dunbartonshire. Est. 2011  
This hazy orange, light and refreshing New England IPA has aromas of stone fruit and pineapple, leading to a citrus fruit explosion and a juicy, sweet finish.  
**Hops:** *Amarillo, Galaxy, Mosaic*



**Oakham Citra 4.6% ABV**  
Oakham Ales, Cambridgeshire. Est. 1993  
This unfiltered session IPA has a hazy golden appearance, exploding in hop character and refreshing fruit notes, balanced by a satin-smooth mouthfeel.  
**Hops:** *Citra*



**Kirkstall Judicious 4.8% ABV**  
Kirkstall Brewery, West Yorkshire. Est. 2011  
This hazy straw-coloured beer is packed with pink grapefruit, pineapple, mango and passion fruit flavours, creating a juicy character with subtle coconut hints.  
**Hops:** *Citra, Mosaic, Talus*



**Fierce IPA 5.0% ABV**  
Fierce Beer, Aberdeenshire. Est. 2016  
This bright golden beer has a sweet, juicy aroma of fruit and caramel, leading to bittersweet citrus zest flavours and a crisp, refreshing finish.  
**Hops:** *Citra, Mosaic*



**Siren Paloma Gose 5.0% ABV**  
Siren Craft Brew, Berkshire. Est. 2013  
This golden-pink slightly hazy beer takes you on a journey of fresh lime and grapefruit, complemented by a sprinkling of sea salt, resulting in a tart, refreshing character.  
**Hops:** *Talus*



**Brew York Time Travelling Taxi 5.4% ABV**  
Brew York Brewery, Yorkshire. Est. 2016  
This hazy golden IPA is brewed with a generous quantity of hops, resulting in strong fruit flavours of citrus, grapefruit and pine, with a refreshing character.  
**Hops:** *Citra, Idaho 7*



**Purple Moose High Hops 5.4% ABV**  
Purple Moose Brewery, Gwynedd. Est. 2005  
This golden tropical IPA has mango and passion fruit aromas, leading to a full-bodied, refreshing character, full of lingering, zesty tropical fruit flavours.  
**Hops:** *Cascade, Ekuanot, Mosaic, Simcoe*



**Indian Juicy Mango 5.5% ABV**  
Indian Brewery, West Midlands. Est. 2014  
This hazy golden pale ale is infused with mango for a powerful fruity aroma and full-bodied, refreshing and juicy fruity character throughout.  
**Hops:** *Citra, Olicana*



**Stewart New Relic 5.6% ABV**  
Stewart Brewing, Midlothian. Est. 2004  
This straw-coloured slightly hazy IPA is full of beautiful stone fruit and blueberry notes, resulting in a full-flavoured character, with a lasting finish.  
**Hops:** *Mosaic*



**Rooster's Tropical Assassin 6.1% ABV**  
Rooster's Brewing, North Yorkshire. Est. 1993  
This pale golden tropical IPA is packed full of mandarin orange and mango hop notes, enhanced by added tropical fruit juice, delivering a distinctive flavour.  
**Hops:** *Citra*



**Seven Bro7hers Buzz 6.0% ABV**  
Seven Bro7hers Brewing, Greater Manchester. Est. 2014  
This light golden beer has a predominant caramel flavour, balanced by a subtle hoppiness, with its honeycomb notes providing a clean, sweet finish.  
**Hops:** *Lubelski*



**Thornbridge West Side Glory 7.0% ABV**  
Thornbridge Brewery, Derbyshire. Est. 2005  
This classic light golden west coast IPA is packed with US hops, delivering powerful pine and grapefruit aromas, along with tangerine and lemon flavours.  
**Hops:** *Centennial, Cryo Citra, Cryo Idaho 7, HBC 1019, Krush*



**Growling Dog Tropical IPA 7.5% ABV**  
Nethergate Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1986  
This hazy golden tropical IPA is bursting with juicy mango, pineapple and papaya flavours, balanced by a crisp hop bitterness for a clean, refreshing finish.  
**Hops:** *Amarillo, Azacca, Idaho 7, Mosaic, Simcoe*

**Brewster’s Winter Draws On 4.0% ABV**  
Brewster’s Brewery, Leicestershire. Est. 1998  
This copper beer delivers sweet caramel and roast flavours, balanced by a diverse hop character of citrus, herbal and spicy notes.  
*Hops: Fuggles, Pacific Jade, Summit*




**Mad Squirrel Stimulus 4.0% ABV**  
Mad Squirrel Brewery, Hertfordshire. Est. 2004  
This straw-coloured beer delivers plenty of vibrant tropical flavours, complemented by a rich malty sweetness and an intense hop character.  
*Hops: Citra, Jester, Mosaic*




**Daleside Old Legover 4.1% ABV**  
Daleside Brewery, North Yorkshire. Est. 1992  
This well-balanced copper ale has fruity and floral aromas, leading to a nutty, predominantly malty flavour, with lingering hops and bitterness in the finish.  
*Hops: Bobek, Goldings, Northern Brewer*




**Branscombe Summa This 4.2% ABV**  
Branscombe Brewery, Devon. Est. 1992  
This amber beer has a heady caramel aroma and initial biscuit flavour, complemented by an emerging light fruitiness and a subtle bitterness in the finish.  
*Hops: Bramling Cross, First Gold, Goldings, Northern Brewer, Perle, Styrian Wolf*



**Nottingham Citra Pale Ale 4.2% ABV**  
Nottingham Brewery, Nottinghamshire. Est. 2000  
This pale golden ale has a full hoppy aroma and plenty of citrus flavour on the palate, leading to a burst of hops in the finish, creating a zesty character.  
*Hops: Bobek, Citra, Fuggles, Goldings*




**Great Newsome Jem’s Stout 4.3% ABV**  
Great Newsome Brewery, East Yorkshire. Est. 2007  
This traditional black stout has a complex aroma of liquorice and hop resin, leading to a complex flavour with coffee and rich malt notes.  
*Hops: Northern Brewer*




**Peerless Jack Frost Blond 4.3% ABV**  
Peerless Brewing, Merseyside. Est. 2009  
This blond seasonal beer greets you with a generous hoppy aroma, leading to a full, refreshing flavour, with moderate bitterness and a zesty citrus hop finish.  
*Hops: Cascade, Citra, First Gold*




**Salem Dark Fruits 4.4% ABV**  
Batemans Brewery, Lincolnshire. Est. 1874  
This black porter has a fruity aroma, leading to a rich, complex (yet velvet-smooth) character, with roasted, nutty notes and dark fruit flavours.  
*Hops: Bobek, Challenger, Goldings*




**Elgood’s Double Swan 4.5% ABV**  
Elgood’s Brewery, Cambridgeshire. Est. 1795  
This blond beer has a floral and hoppy aroma, leading to a crisp character and resulting in a refreshing, long, biscuity finish.  
*Hops: Bramling Cross, Cascade, Challenger, Sovereign*




**Pheasantry Excitra 4.5% ABV**  
Pheasantry Brewery, Nottinghamshire. Est. 2012  
This golden beer highlights all of the characteristics of Citra hops, with an aroma of citrus and fruit notes, followed by bold, pungent hop flavours.  
*Hops: Citra, First Gold*




**Woodforde’s Nog 4.6% ABV**  
Woodforde’s Brewery, Norfolk. Est. 1981  
This is an award-winning, ruby, smooth, rich and rounded old ale, with a velvety texture and hints of chocolate, treacle and liquorice emerging throughout.  
*Hops: Challenger, First Gold, Savinjski*




**Rooster’s 24 Seven 4.7% ABV**  
Rooster’s Brewing, North Yorkshire. Est. 1993  
This pale golden beer has aromas of lemon, tangerine and gooseberry, followed by a refreshing punchbowl of fruit flavours and a balancing grapefruit bitterness.  
*Hops: Amarillo, Nelson Sauvin, Simcoe*




**East London Cowcatcher 4.8% ABV**  
East London Brewing, Leyton. Est. 2011  
This generously hopped American-style ale is pale golden in colour, with its floral aroma leading to a fruity, hoppy flavour and a crisp refreshing finish.  
*Hops: Cascade, Chinook, Citra, Comet, Magnum*




**Vale Gravitas 4.8% ABV**  
Vale Brewery, Buckinghamshire. Est. 1995  
This pale golden ale has a pronounced hop aroma and is packed with hop and citrus flavours, rounded off by a dry, malty, biscuit finish.  
*Hops: Cascade*




**Cairngorm IPA 5.0% ABV**  
Cairngorm Brewery, Highlands. Est. 1997  
This golden beer has pine, tropical fruit and citrus notes in its aroma and flavour. These combine with subtle malt to create a mouth-watering character.  
*Hops: Citra, Columbus, Crystal*




**Conwy American Amber 5.0% ABV**  
Conwy Brewery, Conwy. Est. 2003  
This amber ale has citrus and pine on the nose, leading to biscuit and rich malt flavours, balanced by grapefruit notes in the finish.  
*Hops: Cascade, Centennial, Citra*




**Hop Union Moose River 5.0% ABV**  
Hop Union Brewery, Bristol. Est. 2007  
This golden APA has a sweet citrus aroma, leading to a crisp grapefruit flavour and zesty, fruity character, balanced by undertones of caramel.  
*Hops: Centennial, Mosaic, Tettnang*




**Salcombe Belgica 5.0% ABV**  
Salcombe Brewery, Devon. Est. 2016  
This light amber ale is brewed using Belgian yeast, which provides a distinctive, spicy, fruity aroma, leading to a smooth malt base and gentle hop character.  
*Hops: Admiral, Mandarina Bavaria, Spalter Select*




**Stonehenge Danish Dynamite 5.0% ABV**  
Stonehenge Ales, Wiltshire. Est. 1984  
This golden IPA has a fruity, hoppy aroma, leading to spicy, fruity and hoppy notes in the flavour, with underlying malt notes and a smooth, refreshing finish.  
*Hops: Cascade, Pilgrim*



**Mauldons White Adder 5.3% ABV**  
Mauldons Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1982  
This golden IPA has a distinctive floral nose, with a strong hop character and fruity flavour, with the fruit lingering through to the smooth, hoppy finish.  
*Hops: Goldings*



**Milestone Hammerhead Stout 5.6% ABV**  
Milestone Brewing, Nottinghamshire. Est. 2005  
This black stout has a roasted barley and coffee aroma, leading to a full-bodied malty flavour, with hints of chocolate and liquorice.  
*Hops: Goldings, Magnum, Perle*

**Greene King IPA 3.4% ABV**  
Greene King Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1799  
This easy-drinking amber ale has a fresh, dry, hoppy, herbal character, with satisfying toffee and caramel notes and a clean, dry finish.  
*Hops: Admiral, First Gold, Pilgrim*




**Ruddles Best 3.4% ABV**  
Greene King Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1799  
This amber beer has a soft fruit aroma, leading to hoppy, citrus undertones, a robust bitterness and toffee and caramel notes, resulting in a clean finish.  
*Hops: Admiral, Bramling Cross, Goldings, Pilgrim, Target*




**Belhaven 80 Shilling 3.9% ABV** (Scotland only)  
Belhaven Brewery, East Lothian. Est. 1719  
This copper beer has a malty, moderately sweet character, balanced by a subtle bitterness and underlying orange and herbal hop notes, with hints of toffee.  
*Hops: Challenger, Goldings*



**Sharp’s Doom Bar 4.0% ABV**  
Sharp’s Brewery, Cornwall. Est. 1994  
This amber ale’s aroma of hops and sweet malt leads to a balanced flavour of dried fruit and lightly roasted malt, with a subtle bitterness in the finish.  
*Hops: Aurora, Perle*



**Greene King Abbot Ale 5.0% ABV**  
Greene King Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1799  
This classic deep amber ale has a rich biscuit malt character, balanced by fruity, herbal and spicy hop notes, culminating in a satisfying, warming finish.  
*Hops: Admiral, First Gold, Fuggles, Pilgrim*
