Swannay Birsay Bitter 3.6% ABV

Swannay Brewery, Orkney. Est. 2006
This straw-coloured beer has a floral, fruity aroma, leading to a predominant biscuit malt flavour which is balanced by delicate hop notes.

Hops: East Kent Goldings, Fuggles



Bowman Wallops Wood 4.0% ABV

Bowman Ales, Hampshire. Est. 2006
This chestnut-coloured beer has a pleasing, delicate aroma, leading to a predominantly malty flavour, balanced by subtle hop notes and a hoppy finish.

Hops: Celeia, Galena, Goldings



Frome Funky Monkey 4.0% ABV

Frome Brewing, Somerset. Est. 1999
This copper-coloured ale has a mango and grapefruit aroma, leading to more citrus and tropical fruit notes on the palate, balanced by a subtle bitterness.

Hops: Ahtanum, Olicana



Loch Lomond Bonnie & Blonde 4.0% ABV

Loch Lomond Brewery, West Dunbartonshire. Est. 2011
This straw-coloured ale has floral and orange aromas, leading to a sweet, malty biscuit flavour, balanced by a light, refreshing, citrus finish.

Hops: Amarillo, Cascade, Chinook



Purple Moose Elderflower 4.0% ABV

Purple Moose Brewery, Gwynedd. Est. 2005
This straw-coloured ale has a floral aroma and a sweet citrus finish, with the addition of elderflower providing a distinctive and refreshing character.

Hops: Cascade, Magnum, Pioneer



Adnams Old Ale 4.1% ABV

Adnams Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1872
This deep red ale has a caramel and nutty chocolate aroma and flavour, complemented by liquorice and red fruit notes and a balancing smooth bitterness.

Hops: First Gold



Dorset Jurassic 4.2% ABV

Dorset Brewing, Dorset. Est. 1995
This amber ale delivers a herbal aroma, leading to a crisp, refreshing character, with a malty backbone and apricot notes, plus a lasting bitterness.

Hops: Challenger, Mount Hood



JW Lees Game On 4.2% ABV

JW Lees Brewery, Manchester. Est. 1828
This auburn ale has a malty aroma, leading to a balance of rich maltiness and crisp hop flavours, resulting in a smooth character and refreshing finish.

Hops: Magnum



Rebellion Smuggler 4.2% ABV

Rebellion Brewery, Buckinghamshire Est. 1993

This amber bitter has a distinctive, fruity hop character, with a full, balanced flavour which leads to a lasting, bittersweet finish.

Hops: Amarillo, Fuggles, Goldings



Sambrook's Pumphouse 4.2% ABV

Sambrook's Brewery, London. Est. 2008

This golden pale ale has a spicy, floral aroma, followed by a balanced sweetness and full hop character, resulting in a dry, refreshing finish.

Hops: Ernest, Fuggles, Goldings



Hadrian Border Secret Kingdom 4.3% ABV

Hadrian Border Brewery, Newcastle upon Tyne. Est. 1994

This ruby ale is rich and full bodied, with flavours of toasted malt and honey complemented by citrus notes and a pleasing bitterness.

Hops: Admiral, Cascade, Goldings



Otter Bright 4.3% ABV

Otter Brewery, Devon. Est. 1990

This straw-coloured beer delivers a citrus aroma, followed by a refreshing fruity flavour, resulting in a subtle bittersweet finish.

Hops: Fuggles



Acorn Old Moor 4.4% ABV

Acorn Brewery, South Yorkshire. Est. 2003

This mahogany, award-winning, Victorian-style porter has an initial bitterness and hints of liquorice in its flavour, giving way to a smooth, mellow finish.

Hops: Challenger



Bishop Nick Martyr 4.5% ABV

Bishop Nick Brewery, Essex. Est. 2011

This light amber beer is brewed in the style of an APA, with its blend of hops delivering tropical fruit flavours which are balanced by a sweet biscuit maltiness.

Hops: Chinook, Comet, Simcoe, Willamette



Kirkstall Three Swords 4.5% ABV

Kirkstall Brewery, West Yorkshire. Est. 2011

This blond beer is brewed with a generous blend of three US hop varieties, resulting in a crisp, aromatic character and refreshing citrus fruit notes.

Hops: Cascade, Centennial, Chinook



Magpie Thieving Rogue 4.5% ABV

Magpie Brewery, Nottinghamshire. Est. 2006

This straw-coloured beer has a floral hop character, balanced by light biscuit malt notes, resulting in a clean, refreshing finish.

Hops: Admiral, Goldings



Flack's Black Jack 4.6% ABV

Flack Manor Brewery, Hampshire. Est. 2010

This smooth, deep ruby beer has rich aromas of toasted malts, with an initial sweetness in its flavour, followed by a lingering hop finish and hazelnut notes.

Hops: Fuggles, Goldings



Oakham Bishops Farewell 4.6% ABV

Oakham Ales, Cambridgeshire. Est. 1993

This golden, award-winning beer is dominated by elaborate fruity hop notes, complemented by a full-flavoured background and a dry, refreshing finish.

Hops: Cascade, Challenger



Goddards Fuggle Dee-Dum 4.8% ABV

Goddards Brewery, Isle of Wight. Est. 1993

This amber beer has aromas of roasted malt and smoky, spicy hops, leading to a nutty taste and a pleasing, light, fruity hop dryness in its flavour.

Hops: Fuggles



Green Jack Lurcher Stout 4.8% ABV

Green Jack Brewing, Suffolk. Est. 2003

This rich, smooth stout is black in colour, with a blackcurrant aroma, hoppy bitterness and roasted notes, leading to a subtle sweetness in the finish.

Hops: Bramling Cross, Challenger



Gadds' Dark Conspiracy 4.9% ABV

Ramsgate Brewery, Kent. Est. 2002

This rich, smooth, mahogany porter is brewed with a blend of malts, together with Kent- and US-grown hops, combining to deliver a complex character.

Hops: Cascade (UK), Willamette



Bradfield Farmers Pale Ale 5.0% ABV

Bradfield Brewery, South Yorkshire. Est. 2005

This distinctive, golden, fruity pale ale has a powerful floral bouquet, a well-balanced and full-bodied character and a predominantly dry finish.

Hops: Bramling Cross



Grainstore Ten Fifty 5.0% ABV

The Grainstore Brewery, Rutland. Est. 1995

This full-strength, mahogany beer has a fine balance of hop bitterness and malty sweetness, creating a potent (yet easily drinkable) character.

Hops: Challenger, Fuggles



Loddon Talon APA 5.0% ABV

Loddon Brewery, Oxfordshire. Est. 2002

This straw-coloured beer is brewed in the style of an APA, with aromas of lime, grapefruit and mango leading to a smooth malt flavour and hoppy finish.

Hops: Cascade, Citra, Styrian Wolf



Nethergate Old Growler 5.0% ABV

Nethergate Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1986

This dark and satisfying beer, based on a 1750s porter recipe, has fruity notes and a complex blend of chocolate, coffee and roasted malt flavours.

Hops: Challenger, Sovereign



Salopian Golden Thread 5.0% ABV

Salopian Brewery, Shropshire. Est. 1995

This golden ale is floral, fruity and balanced, with apricot and sorbet notes and a creamy mouthfeel, leading to a subtle, sweet finish.

Hops: Centennial, Simcoe



Wolf Tasmanian Wolf 5.0% ABV

Wolf Brewery, Norfolk. Est. 1995

This deep golden IPA has an inviting aroma which leads to a fine balance of fruity hop notes and malt flavours, resulting in a refreshing finish.

Hops: Pacific Jade, Wakatu



Bays Devon Dumpling 5.1% ABV

Bays Brewery, Devon. Est. 2007

This golden ale has a fresh hop character throughout, delivering an inviting aroma and a full flavour, with its balanced sweetness providing a smooth character.

Hops: Northern Brewer, Sovereign



Stewart Ka Pai 5.2% ABV

Stewart Brewing, Midlothian. Est. 2004

This straw-coloured pale ale delivers passion fruit, lychee and mango on the nose, leading to an initial sweetness, balanced character and lasting bitterness.

Hops: Cascade, Galaxy, Magnum, Nelson Sauvin



Gower Gower Power 5.5% ABV

Gower Brewery, West Glamorgan. Est. 2011

This amber-coloured strong ale is brewed with a generous quantity of hops, balanced by malty and fruity flavours to deliver a rich, warming character.

Hops: Cascade, Columbus, Northern Brewer



Ilkley Lotus 5.5% ABV

Ilkley Brewery, West Yorkshire. Est. 2009

This golden IPA has a tropical fruit aroma, leading to a balance of malt and juicy, fruity hop notes, along with a lasting bitterness in the finish.

Hops: Comet, Ekuanot, Mosaic, Rakau



Exmoor Beast 6.6% ABV

Hogs Back Brewery, Surrey. Est. 1992

This complex black porter has aromas of espresso, currants, cocoa and rum, leading to a rich malt flavour, with hints of chocolate, and a long, hoppy finish.

Hops: Challenger, First Gold, Goldings

Pubs will have three of the below ales available at all times.

Greene King IPA 3.4% ABV

Greene King Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1799

This easy-drinking amber ale has a fresh, dry, hoppy, herbal character, with satisfying toffee and caramel notes and a clean, dry finish.

Hops: Admiral, First Gold, Pilgrim



Ruddles Best 3.4% ABV

Greene King Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1799

This amber beer has a soft fruit aroma, leading to hoppy, citrus undertones, a robust bitterness and toffee and caramel notes, resulting in a clean finish.

Hops: Admiral, Bramling Cross, Goldings, Pilgrim, Target



Belhaven 80 Shilling 3.9% ABV (Scotland only)

Belhaven Brewery, East Lothian. Est. 1719

This copper beer has a malty, moderately sweet character, balanced by a subtle bitterness and underlying orange and herbal hop notes, with hints of toffee.

Hops: Challenger, Goldings



Sharp's Doom Bar 4.0% ABV

Sharp's Brewery, Cornwall. Est. 1994

This amber ale's aroma of hops and sweet malt leads to a balanced flavour of dried fruit and lightly roasted malt, with a subtle bitterness in the finish.

Hops: Aurora, Perle



Greene King Abbot Ale 5.0% ABV

Greene King Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1799

This classic deep amber ale has a rich biscuit malt character, balanced by fruity, herbal and spicy hop notes, culminating in a satisfying, warming finish.

Hops: Admiral, First Gold, Fuggles, Pilgrim
