

CRAFT BEER

A new range of draught craft is launching in Wetherspoon's pubs across the UK, including beer from Hertfordshire brewery Mad Squirrel and Greater Manchester-based Seven Bro7hers. A separate range is available in Scotland, featuring beers from Stewart Brewing and Williams Brothers. The range will vary by pub; use the Wetherspoon app to find availability.



Seven Bro7hers Easy IPA 4.7% ABV

This hazy, straw-coloured pale ale delivers a perfect balance of fruit and resinous hop flavours, complemented by subtle pine notes.

Mad Squirrel \$umo 4.7% ABV

This golden-orange hazy pale ale combines citrus, grapefruit and mango flavours, leading to a dry, bitter finish.

BrewDog Punk IPA 5.2% ABV

Bursts of caramel and tropical fruit, with an all-out riot of grapefruit, pineapple and lychee, precede a spiky, bitter finish.

Tasting notes

Pints

Siren Tempo 3.8% ABV

Siren Craft Brew, Finchampstead, Berkshire. Est. 2013

This straw-coloured beer has a clean malt base, onto which layers of hops provide a range of fruit flavours, culminating in a gentle bitterness and crisp finish.

Hops: Citra, HBC638, Lorien, Meridian

Portobello New Who? 3.9% ABV

Portobello Brewery, Portobello, London. Est. 2012

This golden beer has a balanced hop character and a crisp, refreshing flavour with hints of grapefruit, while its addition of green tea provides a distinctive, zesty finish.

Hops: Amarillo, Cascade, Magnum

Three Acre Ruby Porter 4.2% ABV

Three Acre Brewery, Uckfield, East Sussex. Est. 2018

This mahogany beer has a smooth, easy-drinking character, with its roasted coffee and cocoa flavours complemented by a rich malty base.

Hops: Challenger, Progress

Windsor & Eton Storm 4.2% ABV

Windsor & Eton Brewery, Windsor, Berkshire. Est. 2010

This classic London stout has roasted coffee and dark chocolate aromas, leading to a rich, silky, creamy body and a lingering dry-roasted finish.

Hops: Admiral, Progress

Mad Squirrel Amberillo 4.5% ABV

Mad Squirrel Brewery, Hemel Hempstead, Hertfordshire. Est. 2004

This amber beer has a bright citrus and floral aroma, leading to a smooth malt backbone, with balanced flavours of toasted bread and caramel.

Hops: Amarillo

Redemption West Coast 4.5% ABV

Redemption Brewery, Tottenham, London. Est. 2010

This golden pale ale delivers grapefruit and orange on the nose, leading to marmalade and grapefruit flavours which culminate in a fruity, pronounced, bitter finish.

Hops: Cascade, Chinook, Idaho 7

Sambrook's Wit's End 4.7% ABV

Sambrook's Brewery, Wandsworth, London. Est. 2008

This straw-coloured beer is brewed with a Belgian yeast strain, helping to deliver hints of spice, lemon and cloves and a creamy character, balanced by fruity hop notes.

Hops: Bullion, Cascade (UK)

Wimbledon Hounds of Helles 4.8% ABV

Wimbledon Brewery, Wimbledon, London. Est. 2015

This mahogany dunkel-style beer is full of caramel and roasted malt notes, yet delivers a clean, crisp, refreshing character.

Hops: Hallertau Blanc, Huell Melon, Perle

Southwark Biscuit Town Porter 5.0% ABV

Southwark Brewing, Southwark, London. Est. 2014

Taking its name from the nickname for a part of London, this black beer is full of biscuit aromas and flavours, complemented by malty notes and a subtle bitterness.

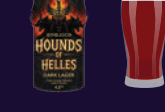
Hops: East Kent Goldings, Fuggles, Northern Brewer

Signature Backstage IPA 5.2% ABV

Signature Brew, Walthamstow, London. Est. 2011

This light amber beer features a packed set-list of passion fruit, tangerines and berries, leading to an encore, in its finish, of pine and crisp citrus notes.

Hops: Magnum, Mosaic, Simcoe

Twickenham Starry Night 5.4% ABV

Twickenham Brewery, Twickenham, London. Est. 2004

This chestnut-coloured beer is brewed in the classic ESB style, with rich caramel and toffee notes helping to deliver a lasting, warming character.

Hops: East Kent Goldings, Fuggles



Burning Sky Aurora Australis 5.6% ABV

Burning Sky Brewery, Firle, East Sussex. Est. 2013

This light golden beer has a tropical fruit aroma, with notes of white grape, passion fruit, lychee and lime which continue into the flavour, balanced by a crisp malt backbone and a clean, refreshing finish.

Hops: Motueka, Nelson Sauvin, Riwaka



Cans

Oakham Citra 4.6% ABV

Oakham Ales, Cambridgeshire. Est. 1993

This unfiltered session IPA has a hazy golden appearance, exploding in hop character and refreshing fruit notes, balanced by a satin-smooth mouthfeel.

Hops: Citra



Siren Paloma Gose 5.0% ABV

Siren Craft Brew, Berkshire. Est. 2013

This golden-pink slightly hazy beer takes you on a journey of fresh lime and grapefruit, complemented by a sprinkling of sea salt, resulting in a tart, refreshing character.

Hops: Talus



Growling Dog Tropical IPA 7.5% ABV

Nethergate Brewery, Suffolk. Est. 1986

This hazy golden tropical IPA is bursting with juicy mango, pineapple and papaya flavours, balanced by a crisp hop bitterness for a clean, refreshing finish.

Hops: Amarillo, Azacca, Idaho 7, Mosaic, Simcoe
